EVWD RECEIVES FIRST PLACE HONOR AT IE TOP WORKPLACES CEREMONY *The Press Enterprise recognizes District as a leader in the small company category*

Highland, Calif., (January 30, 2017) – East Valley Water District (District) is committed to providing employment development opportunities for District employees to grow professionally. As part of this commitment, the District participated in The Press Enterprise’s Top Workplaces Program, which provides an opportunity for employees to provide open and honest feedback. EVWD uses the information gathered to implement new employee-focused programs or make adjustments to existing initiatives.

Ninety-three percent of the District’s workforce participated in the survey resulting in a first place award in the small company category at The Press Enterprise Inland Empire Top Workplaces awards ceremony held Thursday, December 1, 2016.

“This award reinforces the District’s efforts as a leader beyond the water industry,” said Board Chairman Ron Coats. “It is only through the participation of staff that we are able to accomplish such amazing feats.”

In its third year, the Press Enterprise event anticipates becoming the most respected and popular source for ranking workplace quality in the Inland Empire. Based on anonymous input from employee feedback surveys, the awards assess businesses of all sizes according to 22 survey statements on topics such as compensation, benefits, job satisfaction, and social responsibility. Winners are ranked in three categories: large, mid-size and small companies.

“It was a privilege to accept this award on behalf of the employees of East Valley Water District,” said John Mura, CEO/General Manager. “We have been honored with several awards in recent years, but none are as rewarding as this one.”
