TWO EVWD BOARD SEATS UP FOR ELECTION IN NOVEMBER *Candidate Filing Begins July 13 Through August 7*

Highland, Calif., (July 6, 2020) – In 2020, East Valley Water will have two Board of Directors seats up for election. The East Valley Water District is a California Special District, independent government agency that provides water and wastewater services to the customers within its boundaries. The District is governed by a five-member elected Board of Directors who serve as policymakers that guide the District to meet its mission. Board members are elected to staggered 4-year terms.

Community members interested in running are encouraged to visit the San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters offices to request candidate filing documents. Candidate filing begins July 13, 2020, and closes on August 7, 2020, at 5:00 pm.

“As an agency that strives to provide world class public service, East Valley Water District values community participation,” said John Mura, General Manager/CEO. “We encourage engagement in the governance and election process to help guide the District’s goals and objectives.”

The San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters serves as the election officer and is responsible for all candidates' filings, the issuance and acceptance of nomination papers. Registrar of Voters offices are located at 777 E. Rialto Avenue, San Bernardino, CA 92415. Applicants must be registered voters living within the District’s service area, over 18 years of age, and have not been convicted of a crime that would prevent them from holding a public office.
